

# Thank you for your support!

Wow – 2022 was another rough year for many people, and you came through for the American Baptist Historical Society! Thank you! **Thanks to ABHS members and donors**, we

- \* completed the digitization of audio tapes of American Baptist Conventions from 1958-1973 and are now ingesting the files into the digital preservation platform, where they will be accessible online;
- ★ began a collaborative project with Ancestry.com. An Ancestry contractor is currently scanning ABFMS/IM missionary bio files. The project also includes some original church records, MMBB data sheets, and a set of scrapbooks with newspaper clippings on notable Baptists; we estimated 500,000 pages to be digitized (and this represents about 1% of our collections);
- \* continued cataloging our rare books in the WorldCat online catalog. Of our roughly 2600 items listed in WorldCat, 74 are unique holdings and another 998 are held by 2-10 libraries worldwide;
- **★** celebrated 58 congregations' histories of ministry by sending them an Anniversary Certificate;
- \* welcomed over 60 visitors and researchers on-site, and fulfilled over 75 Research-by-Mail requests. Your generosity also made it possible for ABHS staff to participate both virtually and in-person in regional conferences and region annual meetings. Executive Director Priscilla Eppinger was named Conference Historian for the "Celebrating Ministering Women: Radical. Redeemed. Ready." conference that was sponsored by American Baptist Women in Ministry, and led two workshops during that Green Lake conference in June 2022. In September, at the invitation of the Japanese American National Museum in Los Angeles, Eppinger participated in a dedication ceremony for a memorial to the 122,000 people of Japanese descent who were interned during World War II.

Funds to carry out this work come from institutional partners and from individuals. We are grateful to Mercer University and President Bill Underwood for hosting ABHS on their Atlanta campus. We appreciate financial support from American Baptist Churches, USA, International Ministries, American Baptist Home Mission Societies, the Ministers and Missionaries Benefit Board, and American Baptist Women's Ministries, all of whose records of ministry we preserve and manage.





### William H. Brackney, January 30, 1948 - November 13, 2022 ABHS Executive Director, 1978-1986

As the first person to hold the title of "Executive Director" of the American Baptist Historical Society, Rev. Dr. William H. Brackney left an indelible mark on the Society. (Earlier administrators bore the title of "Curator.") During Brackney's tenure as Executive Director, ABHS became the permanent custodian of the records of the national boards of American Baptist Churches, USA, the Philadelphia Baptist Association, and the Freewill Baptist movement in North America. We can credit Bill Brackney with initiating the Archives Center at the ABCUSA headquarters at Valley Forge, PA. With the addition of ongoing exhibits at Green Lake, WI, ABHS expanded to three sites.



Bill Brackney came to ABHS in 1978 from Colgate Rochester Divinity School in Rochester, NY, where he served as Associate Professor of Church History. Ordained to ministry in 1971, Bill sometimes served as a pastor alongside his academic tenure. During the eight years that he served as Executive Director of ABHS, both denominational archives and manuscript collections expanded. Part of the historical library was reclassified from the Dewey Decimal to the Library of Congress system. Many original copies of newspapers (mostly 19th-century) were microfilmed. ABHS still makes use of the guide to manuscript collections that he and Susan Eltscher compiled.

Bill's numerable publications, projects that he spearheaded, and research were unmatched among Baptist historians. His knowledge of Baptist history and the historians who study it was immense! Bill was very involved in the 2018 Rauschenbusch Conference that ABHS co-hosted with Mercer University and the Acadia Centre for Baptist and Anabaptist Studies. This jointly-sponsored conference was an example of collaborative work that Bill liked to organize.

In 1986, William Brackney resigned from ABHS to become Vice President and Dean and Professor of the History of Christianity at Eastern Baptist Theological Seminary (now Palmer Seminary, St. Davids, PA). He subsequently served as an administrator and faculty member at McMaster Divinity College (Hamilton, ON), Baylor University (Waco, TX), Acadia Divinity College (Wolfville, NS), and Carey Theological College (Vancouver, BC). He died on November 13, 2022 in Kentville, Nova Scotia, and a memorial service was held on November 17, 2022, at Wolfville Baptist Church.

We offer our condolences to Bill's widow, Kitty, and their children and grandchildren.



Emerging scholars are invited to submit essays in any area of Baptist history for the Torbet Prize competition.

Each year ABHS invites essays from authors who have not already published a major scholarly work. The Research and Publication Committee of the ABHS Board of Managers serves as judges, and the winning essay is eligible for publication in an upcoming issue of the *American Baptist Quarterly* and its author awarded a cash prize.

Entries should be no more than 25 double-spaced pages (excluding notes) with citations following the *Chicago Manual of Style*. Send entries to ABHSoffice@ABHSarchives.org. The submission deadline for the next award is September 1, 2023.

Robert George Torbet (1912-1995) was an American Baptist historian and educator. His significant contributions to Baptist research and publication led the American Baptist Historical Society to establish a prize in his honor to encourage development of young scholars in the field of Baptist history studies.
